



## Website Accessibility statement

The Weedon Bec Village website is hosted by 2commune and managed by nominated members of the Parish Council. We want as many people as possible to be able to use this website. You should be able to:

- change colours, contrast levels and fonts
- zoom in up to 300% without the text spilling off the screen
- navigate most of the website using just a keyboard
- navigate most of the website using speech recognition software
- listen to most of the website using a screen reader (including the most recent versions of JAWS, NVDA and VoiceOver)

We've also made the website text as simple as possible to understand.

### How accessible this website is:

We know that some parts of this website may not be fully accessible:

### **Disproportionate burden**

The Parish Council does not provide any services specifically for disabled users for example, 'apply for Blue Badges', and does not provide any services that enable individuals to participate in society, like 'register to vote' or 'find a job

Content that's not within the scope of the accessibility regulations  
ie 3rd party products

- We use Google maps. These may not be accessible to some people. We will always provide the information by alternative means on request
- Social media share bars may not meet the required colour contrast levels

We do not plan to add captions to live video streams because live video is exempt from meeting the accessibility regulations.

The accessibility regulations do not require us to fix PDFs or other documents published before 23 September 2018 if they're not essential to providing our services.

### **Interactive tools and transactions**

We've assessed the cost of fixing the issues with navigation and accessing information, and with interactive tools and transactions. We believe that doing so now would be a disproportionate burden within the meaning of the accessibility regulations.

### **How we tested this website**

This website was tested on 14th August 2020. The test was carried out by [2commune Limited](#).

This website was tested on 16<sup>th</sup> September 2020. The test was carried out by ourselves.

We used the methodology described in "Website Accessibility Requirements" produced by [NALC](#). This website was tested using the Microsoft [Accessibility Insights for Web](#) tool recommend in that publication.
